The 2021 Soil Your Undies Challenge is a collaboration between Dr Oliver Knox, CottonInfo, UNE SMART Farms and UNE Discovery, and aims to create broadscale engagement of school age children Australia wide. This challenge is an opportunity for citizens to become scientists, and not only collect data themselves, but to learn about soil acidity and alkalinity (pH), temperature, moisture, and the processes whereby the soil breaks down cotton underpants. By participating in the Soil Your Undies Challenge in Term 4, 2020, Australians can contribute to a broader research project conducted by Dr Oliver Knox and CottonInfo, and engage with UNE for a fun and educational experience.

To be eligible for the participation prize, organising individuals must submit up to six photos of their Soil Your Undies journey with their children/students, as outlined in the [Terms and Conditions](#). **As participants are under the age of 18 years, they are required to obtain their parent's or guardian's permission to enter the challenge and agree to these terms, and will be deemed to have obtained such permission by submitting photo entries.** This permission note and image release form is provided for your convenience and does not need to be returned to UNE Discovery.
